Driving Progress Through Efficient Public Administration Delivery

The annals of world history vividly illustrate that civilisations reaching their pinnacle did so by recognising and embracing the principles of good governance which ultimately led to the establishment of welfare states as perceived by Gandhiji, King Vikramaditya and Ashoka's empires and several others that merit mention. The rulers of these kingdoms implemented governance models carefully crafted to prioritise the well-being of their subjects, aiming to approach the ideal of a utopian society. In return, these rulers garnered the unwavering trust and confidence of their subjects, who bestowed upon them a steadfast faith in their leadership.

Gandhiji often emphasised that the real India resided in its villages. By this, he meant that the basic village dwellings served as the cradle of democracy and their humble inhabitants were the torchbearers of the core principles of democracy. Gandhiji recognised

that democracy was deeply rooted in these simple communities, given India's historical commitment to egalitarianism. So when the country became independent, these villages were bestowed with *Panchayati Raj* that could be considered as the precursor to the vibrant and humming democracy of the country.

Administrative Reforms Commissions

Administrative Reforms Commissions (ARCs) have played a significant role in improving the efficiency, transparency, and effectiveness of administrative systems within governments. Till now, two ARCs have come for examining the public administrative system of the country and to make recommendations for reform. The first ARC was established on January 5, 1966, and the second on August 31, 2005. The First ARC was chaired by Shri Morarji Desai, and after he relinquished the charge, Shri Hanumanthaiya took it over, and the second was



chaired by Shri Veerappa Moily. The ARCs are mandated to ensure high standards of efficiency and integrity in public services, and to make public administration responsive to the people. ARC reports are revered among the IAS fraternity like a bible whose recommendations need to be imbibed by all the civil servants to overcome tricky

administrative issues.

In line with tradition, the Government of India, recognising the nation's penchant for effective governance, introduced the Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration. These prestigious accolades honour outstanding contributions and achievements in public administration, aiming to

inspire innovative practices that enhance the efficiency, effectiveness, and responsiveness of the country's governance systems. Established in 2006, these awards boast of a distinguished legacy, rooted in the overarching objective of promoting the welfare of the populace. They commend remarkable initiatives and projects undertaken by civil servants and organisations across all tiers of government, spanning central, state, and local administrations. Encompassing a diverse array of categories from administrative innovation to transparency and accountability—they serve as a beacon for fostering citizen-centric governance.

Genesis of the Awards

"Civil Service" word dates back to the British time when the British East India Company civilian staffs were involved in administrative jobs and were known as 'Public Servants'. Its foundation was laid by Governor

Strategies to Crack the Civil Services Examination: Insights from a Top Performer Ms. Kritika Mishra

Among those who have tasted triumph in this prestigious examination is Ms. Kritika Mishra, an IAS officer hailing from Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh. Clinching the impressive 66th rank in the UPSC Exam 2022, her achievement is further embellished by her distinction as the top performer among UPSC Hindi medium aspirants.

In an interview with Sudit Mishra of Employment News,



Kritika shares her journey, shedding light on the challenges she encountered and the strategies she employed to overcome them. With the UPSC 2024 examination beckoning, Kritika offers a glimpse into her comprehensive preparation plan, providing aspirants with a roadmap to navigate the daunting terrain of the UPSC examination with confidence and poise. Here, we present some of the invaluable tips, gleaned from her experience and dedication to excellence.

Q1: Could you briefly share your preparation strategy for

the UPSC Civil Services Examination? What challenges did you encounter during preparation, and how did you overcome them?

A: My UPSC preparation started alongside my academic pursuits. Despite reaching the interview stage in 2021, I didn't succeed. Doubts about my preparation and strategy started creeping in. However, with family support and self-belief, I confronted these challenges. It's a phase where fear of failure transforms into a tool for success. I analysed my failures, worked on them, and charted a clearer path to success.

Q2: What areas should candidates focus when preparing for the preliminary examination? Which resources did you use, and how beneficial was the internet?

A: To ace the preliminary

exam, analyse past questions and focus on NCERT books for foundational knowledge. Newspapers are invaluable for current affairs, and magazines provide comprehensive coverage. Understanding the nature of questions is crucial, and practicing mock tests is essential. The internet supplements learning by offering insights into current affairs and concepts, enriching preparation.

Q3: What was your optional subject for the main examination, and how did you approach it? Which books did you use, and could you elaborate on your strategy?

A: With a passion for Hindi, I chose Hindi literature as my optional subject. I would suggest aspirants to opt for subjects with ample study material and scoring potential. Study materials

Mission Shakti: Turning Point in India's Space Defence Technology

In the annals of India's scientific and defense history, few events shine as brightly as the culmination of Mission Shakti. In the year 2019, India achieved a milestone that reverberated across the globe, marking a pivotal moment in its science, space, and defense endeavours. It was the year

It was a clear message to the global community that "India has arrived." And as the scientists at DRDO celebrated their triumph, the world took notice. India accomplished the seemingly impossible, solidi-

fying its position in the annals of space defence history.

This meticulously planned and executed mission demonstrated India's capability to protect its space-based assets while honouring its commitment to international treaties promoting the peaceful

the indigenous development of critical technologies by DRDO. From the conception of the mission to its execution, every aspect, including configuration, aerodynamics, propulsion, and mission design, was meticulously crafted by Indian scientists



when India's indomitable spirit of innovation and self-reliance came to fruition in the form of an indigenous Anti-Satellite (ASAT) weapon system. The successful testing of this homegrown technology not only showcased India's formidable capabilities in the realm of space defense but also underscored its unwavering commitment to safeguarding national security interests. As we delve into the intricacies of Mission Shakti, we unravel the journey of determination, ingenuity, and scientific excellence that propelled India into the league of nations possessing such advanced capabilities.

The development of the Anti-Satellite (ASAT) weapon system highlighted India's dedication to bolstering its defence capabilities and promoting collaboration in space exploration on an international scale. As a signatory to the 1967 Outer Space Treaty, this pursuit of space exploration had to align with India's stance against the militarisation of outer space, reinforcing its belief in space as a shared heritage of mankind.

The DRDO, leveraging its extensive experience in ballistic missile defence, was entrusted with this monumental challenge. Aware of the high stakes and global scrutiny, the

After careful consideration, India opted for the 'Hard kill'. Extensive groundwork ensued, requiring the development of radars, mission control centers, launch control centers, and the missile interceptors themselves from the ground up. The ASAT system stood as a marvel of engineering, integrating long-range boosters with a hit-to-kill vehicle, all orchestrated by a sophisticated network of radars and command systems.

Operation Mission Shakti

Cloaked in secrecy, the Mission Shakti project appeared as a routine ballistic missile test. Nearly 150 scientists laboured tirelessly, resulting in a 13-meter-tall interceptor missile poised to defend India's space sovereignty.

The ASAT missile functioned as a hunter, its target a satellite orbiting Earth at 8 kilometers per second. The pursuit commenced with a radar pulse, a signal in the vastness of space, homing in on the metallic body of the enemy satellite. Once locked onto the target, the missile's software would calculate the optimal moment to strike. At the core of the missile was the kill vehicle, outfitted with an Imaging Infrared (IIR) Seeker. Serving

- On March 27, 2019, in Mission Shakti, the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully neutralised a satellite in space using its anti-satellite (ASAT) missile.
- The success of the mission showcased DRDO's technical expertise and capability to safeguard the nation's assets in space, the fourth dimension of warfare.
- The mission represented one of DRDO's most complex operations, requiring a ground-launched missile to precisely hit and neutralise a swiftly moving satellite orbiting hundreds of kilometres away.
- The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has created a video documentary focusing on Mission Shakti, for children aged 7-14. This documentary is available in English, 11 Indian languages, and 2 sign languages for the hearing impaired, intended for showcasing in schools nationwide.

use of outer space. Unlike conventional weaponry, India's ASAT missile employed a "kinetic kill" approach, precisely striking the target satellite, Microsatellite-R, without the need for explosives.

Mission Shakti: Triumph of Indigenous Technology in Satellite Interception

What set Mission Shakti apart was not just its success but

and engineers. Thousands of trial runs were conducted in simulation mode to ensure the precision needed to intercept a target satellite flying at an altitude of 283 kilometres, with a closing velocity of 10.8 kilometres per second.

In an ever-evolving technological landscape, India remains vigilant against emerging threats. The ASAT capability provided by Mission Shakti serves as a deterrent against potential adversaries aiming to exploit vulnerabilities in space-based infrastructure.

Moreover, the successful realisation of Mission Shakti not only elevated India's standing in space technology but also demonstrated its ability to adapt and innovate within tight timelines. The development of the ASAT weapon system, from concept to execution, in a record time of two years, underscored India's commitment to maintaining its position at the forefront of technological advancements.

As India continues its journey in space exploration and defence, Mission Shakti stands as a testament to the nation's ingenuity, resilience and dedication to ensuring the safety and security of its citizens and assets, both on Earth and beyond.

Technical Components of ASAT

1. Kill Vehicle:

- The top portion of the missile responsible for intercepting and colliding with the satellite.
- Operates autonomously without the use of explosives.
- Analogous to a human being, it has specific functions.

2. Imaging Infrared (IIR) Seeker:

- Acts as the "eyes" of the kill vehicle.
- Detects infrared light emitted by the satellite (due to its temperature above absolute zero).
- Provides continuous tracking information about the satellite's position.

3. On-Board Computer (OBC):

- The "brain" of the kill vehicle.
- Receives data from the IIR seeker and information about the kill vehicle's position and velocity from the Inertial Navigation System (INS).
- Processes this data to determine the precise steering direction.

4. Inertial Navigation System (INS):

- Tells the OBC the kill vehicle's current position and orientation.
- Provides critical information for accurate targeting.

5. Divert and Attitude Control System (DACS):

- Consists of:
 - Four liquid rocket engines for precise movement (left-right, up-down).
 - Eight small rockets at the back of the kill vehicle for orientation.
- Executes commands from the OBC in an ultra-fast response time (1/100th of a second).
- Adjusts the kill vehicle's path rapidly (50 to 100 times per second) to hit the satellite with precision.

6. Final Approach:

- In the last few seconds, the kill vehicle fine-tunes its trajectory.
- Aims to strike the satellite dead centre with a relative velocity of 11 km/sec.

This intricate system combines advanced software, precise sensors, and rapid manoeuvrability to achieve the critical task of neutralising satellites. The DACS ensures that the kill vehicle hits its target with remarkable accuracy, even in the challenging final moments of interception.

like 'Hindi Sahitya Ka Saral Itihas' by Vishwanath Tripathi and NCERT's literature introductions are essential. Understanding authors and their themes is key. Practice writing essays in a structured format, incorporating relevant quotes for depth.

Q4: The general studies papers in the main exami-

nation carry significant weight. How did you structure your answers to these papers?

A: When tackling the main examination, it's vital to address all components of the question by organising a structured response, a strong introduction and conclusion. Conclude with innovative solutions to the problems posed in the question,

maintaining a positive outlook. Utilise a point-wise format where applicable and incorporate visual aids like charts, graphs, and maps to enhance clarity.

Q5: What areas did you prioritise when preparing for the general studies papers? Did you seek assistance from coaching institutions? What advice do you have for candidates who cannot afford coaching?

A: The ethics paper revolves around everyday decision-

making, making coaching unnecessary and integrity paramount. Study the Second Administrative Reforms Commission (ARC) report for valuable insights, noting significant quotes for inclusion in your answers. Familiarise yourself with the principles of various thinkers and apply them judiciously. Practice case studies, infusing your answers with unique and positive suggestions.

Q6: How crucial were mock tests in your preparation, and how did they contribute to your interview readiness?

A: Mock tests in both the preliminary and main exams are invaluable for subject mastery and refining strategy. Aim to complete mock tests within the allotted time, learning from errors to enhance performance. While mock interviews offer practice, remember that they may differ significantly from the actual UPSC interview. Prioritise confidence in your abilities and authentic self-expression during interview preparation, minimising reliance on mock interviews.

Q7: What were your key focuses before facing the interview board, and how did you prepare for it? Please elaborate.

A: Prior to facing the interview board, emphasis should be placed on sincerity, integrity, and authenticity, avoiding artificiality. Interview preparation largely hinges on the Detailed Application Form (DAF) so prepare accordingly and gather pertinent background information. Remember that hobbies and extracurricular activities reflect your personality, so ensure thorough preparation for answering questions related to your hobbies and extracurricular activities as well.

Q8: Why do you think there's a significant gap in the performance of English and Hindi background students?

A: Indeed, this question is increasingly intricate. The

primary reason lies in the scarcity of study materials. The available resources in Hindi often lack the requisite quality to clear a rigorous exam like the UPSC. Additionally, many optional subjects suffer from a dearth of study materials in Hindi. Furthermore, when it comes to current affairs, the gap widens further. In such circumstances, Hindi medium candidates should leverage online translation tools while ensuring content accessibility in English.

Q9: How do you suggest balancing UPSC Civil Services preparation alongside employment to achieve success?

A: In today's landscape, effective time management reigns supreme. Maintaining a positive mindset is crucial during this period, as the greatest battle unfolds within the mind itself. While juggling a job, it's advisable to assess one's available time and utilise it efficiently.

Q10: Many aspirants believe that effective preparation necessitates living away from home, yet you chose to prepare at home. What's your perspective on this?

A: In the digital age, physical relocation for preparation is no longer imperative as study materials are readily accessible online. Moreover, preparing at home alleviates the financial strain on middle-class families. Steering clear of herd mentality, we should instill confidence in ourselves and, when necessary, visit centers like Delhi to acquire new study materials, purchase mock tests, and continue preparation at home.

Q11: How did materials published by Publications Division like Employment News/ Rozgar Samachar, Yojana, Kurukshetra, India Year Book, etc., aid in your preparation?

A: Monthly magazines like Yojana and Kurukshetra are invaluable assets for Hindi medium candidates. Candidates should regard the language utilised in these publications as the benchmark and incorporate similar language and vocabulary in their answers for optimal results. During the main examination, I utilised these magazines to prepare for various topics like agriculture, women empowerment, etc. Engaging with any point related to a subject typically covers most subtopics of the main exam. This strategy saves time and enriches answers. Additionally, Rozgar Samachar served as a steadfast companion throughout the preparation journey, offering insights into vacancies, application procedures, and examination-related policies.

3. Reservation of Vacancies

General Lord Warren Hastings and later more reforms were introduced by Governor General Lord Cornwallis who was given the epithet of "Father of Civil Services in India". Lord Cornwallis introduced two divisions of the Indian Civil Service covenanted and uncovenanted. The covenanted civil service consisted of only Europeans (i.e., British personnel) occupying the higher posts in the government. The uncovenanted civil service was solely introduced to facilitate the entry of Indians at the lower rungs of the administration.

After a long drawn battle, the country became free, but with it came gigantic administrative challenges that a new born nation has to face. Sensing this precarious situation, Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel rose to the occasion and guided the first batch of probationers of Indian Administrative Service (IAS) in 1947 at Metcalfe House, New Delhi with these words "You are the pioneers in the Indian Service, and the future of this Service will depend much upon the foundation and traditions that will be laid down by you, by your character and abilities and by your spirit of service." He added: "The days of the Indian Civil Service of the old style are going to be over and in its place we have brought into being the All-India Administrative Service. The change is both significant and epoch-making. In the first place, it is an unmistakable symptom of the transfer of power which is taking place from foreign to

Indian hands. Secondly, it marks the inauguration of the All India Service officers entirely by Indians and subject completely to Indian control. Thirdly, the Service will now be free to or will have to adopt its true role of national service without being trammled by traditions and habits of the past..."

To commemorate this day when the then Home Minister, Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel addressed the ICS probationers on 21st April 1947, 21st April is celebrated as the Civil Services Day as an occasion for the civil servants to rededicate themselves to the cause of the citizens and renew their commitments to public service and excellence in work. A department under the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, namely, 'Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances' (DARPG) has been entrusted with the work of commemorating this historic day on 21st April of every year.

Awards Criteria

■ ECI Terms Unverified Messages about Missing EVMs as False

The Election Commission of India (ECI) termed as false the claim of messages being circulated on WhatsApp that 15 lakh EVMs are missing. It further asserted that no EVMs are missing and the Supreme Court has also dismissed the petitions on missing EVMs. The ECI said that for authentic information people must visit the commission's official website. Meanwhile, Chief Election Commissioner Shri Rajiv Kumar directed Municipal Commissioners and District Election Officers from select districts to prepare a booth wise action plan for enhanced voter participation and behavioural change. He also asked them to prepare different strategies for urban and rural areas and plan interventions accordingly for different targeted audiences. The CEC has identified 215 rural and 51 urban parliamentary constituencies with low voter turnout to reach out to voters in a targeted manner.

■ First Tri-service Conference 'Parivartan Chintan' Held In New Delhi

The first-ever Tri-service Conference 'Parivartan Chintan' was held in New Delhi on April 8. During the conference Chief of Defence Staff, General Anil Chauhan highlighted the need for developing a joint culture for the armed forces. He also stressed upon the need to integrate the capabilities of each service by creating structures that enhance war fighting ability and interoperability. Strategic issues impacting national security in civil and military domains were also deliberated upon by the officials. Chiefs of Staff Committee, Lieutenant General JP Mathew expressed confidence that such interactions will provide the necessary guidelines as joint operational structures evolve to transform to a future ready Indian Armed forces.



■ UGC Takes Steps to Increase Awareness about Students' Mental Health Helpline

The University Grants Commission has instructed all higher educational institutions to create awareness amongst the students about the availability of toll-free mental health helpline. The commission requested the higher educational institutions to widely publicise the Tele MANAS helpline, stating that it is free of cost and available 24x7. Tele MANAS provides toll free services with full confidentiality. The service is currently catering to over 13 hundred calls per day in 20 languages.

■ JNU Emerges as Highest Ranked Indian University in World University Rankings



The Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) emerged as the highest-ranked Indian university in the World University Rankings list released by London-based higher education analytics firm, Quacquarelli Symonds (QS). Under the subject of Development Studies, JNU was ranked 20th. A total of 69 Indian

universities made it to the rankings with 424 entries across all subjects. It is 19.4% higher than the previous year's 355 entries. Further, the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Ahmedabad is among the top 25 institutions around the globe for business and management studies while IIM-Bangalore and Calcutta are in the top 50.

■ IMD Incorporates AI, ML in Weather Forecasting

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has started using Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) in weather forecasts, and it will expand it further into other areas to improve forecasts in coming years. IMD's Director General Shri Mrutyunjay Mohapatra said a dedicated expert team has been formed to spearhead the development of this AI-based tool. Additionally, collaborations have been established with the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) and Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs) to harness their expertise in AI and ML. According to experts, one of the key advantages of AI and ML in weather forecasting lies in their ability to process large volumes of historical weather data and real-time observation.

■ ISRO's Chandrayaan-3 Mission Team Honoured with 2024 John L 'Jack' Swigert Jr. Award

The ISRO Chandrayaan-3 mission team has been honoured with the 2024 John L 'Jack' Swigert Jr. Award for Space Exploration by the Space Foundation, USA. This prestigious award, given annually, celebrates remarkable achievements in space exploration and discovery by space agencies, companies, or consortia of organisations. Space Foundation CEO Mr. Heather Pringle praised India's leadership in space, highlighting the Chandrayaan-3 mission's technical and engineering excellence.

■ CBSE Alters Evaluation Pattern for Classes XI and XII

CBSE has revamped the assessment and evaluation pattern for classes XI and XII starting from the academic year 2024-25. The changes prioritise competency-based questions. Constructed-response questions in theory exams will now hold a reduced weightage of 30%, down from 40%. Meanwhile, competency-focused



questions, like MCQs and case-based queries, will increase to 50%. CBSE stated that such questions evaluate real-life application of concepts. MCQs will retain 20% weightage, maintaining their significance. These alterations aim to enhance students' competency levels in line with the evolving educational landscape.

■ UNHRC Adopts Landmark Resolution to Protect Intersex Rights

The United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) made history by unanimously adopting a resolution aimed at safeguarding the rights of intersex people. Spearheaded by Finland, South Africa, Chile, and Australia, the resolution received overwhelming support, with 24 countries in favour and none against. The initiative addresses discrimination, violence, and harmful practices faced by intersex individuals, emphasising the right to physical and mental health. The resolution also calls for a comprehensive report on discriminatory laws and policies from the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights. This groundbreaking step underscores growing international commitment to addressing intersex rights violations.



■ Israel Partially Pulls Out Troops from Gaza Strip

Israel has pulled its ground forces out of the southern Gaza Strip in a partial withdrawal. The move comes after six months of devastating war triggered by the terror attacks on Israel on 7th of October last year by the Palestinian group Hamas. The Israeli military however said that a significant force will keep operating elsewhere in the besieged Palestinian territory to conduct precise intelligence-based operations. As new truce talks are due to be held in Cairo, Israeli Prime Minister Mr. Benjamin Netanyahu said, there will be no ceasefire without the return of hostages. He stressed that Israel is ready for a deal, but not ready to surrender.

■ Inflation to Hover Around 4.5% during Current Fiscal



The Consumer Price Inflation (CPI) for 2024-25 is projected at 4.5%, according to the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). The RBI Governor Shri Shaktikanta Das said that in comparison to the 7.8% peak in April 2022, inflation has come down significantly; however, it remains above the original

target of 4%. Meanwhile, India's Foreign Exchange Reserves reached an all-time high of US\$ 645.6 billion as of March 29th this year.

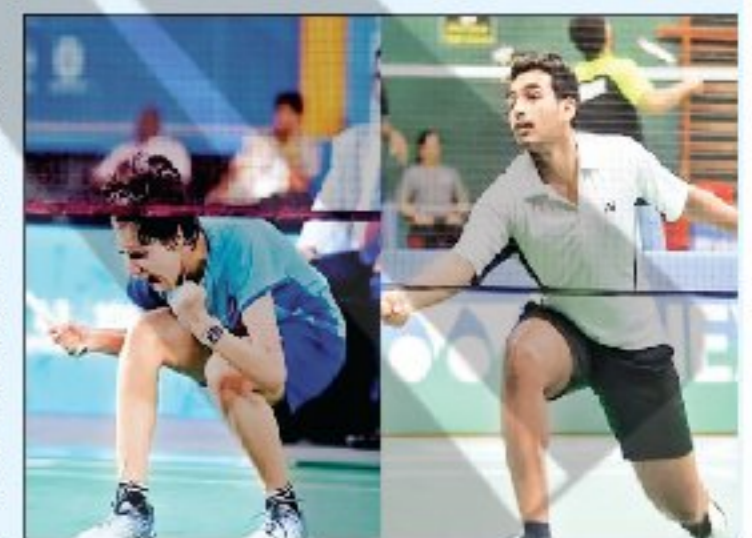
■ WTO Forecasts Gradual Recovery in Global Goods Trade

World Trade Organization (WTO) economists anticipate a gradual uptick in global goods trade this year, rebounding from a 2023 contraction due to high energy prices and inflation. The volume of world merchandise trade is projected to rise by 2.6% in 2024 and 3.3% in 2025 after a 1.2% dip in 2023. Despite this optimism, regional conflicts and economic uncertainties pose significant risks to the forecast. The WTO stresses the importance of resilient supply chains and a solid multilateral trading framework for sustained recovery, underlining the need to address geopolitical tensions and trade fragmentation.

Shuttlers Anupama Upadhyaya and M. Tharun emerged victorious in the women's and men's singles categories at the Kazakhstan International Challenge in Astana. Upadhyaya defeated Isharani Baruah in a thrilling all-Indian final, while Tharun secured his first senior title by defeating Malaysian Soong Joo Ven. The former Junior World No. 1 Upadhyaya adds another accolade to her impressive career, while Tharun marks a significant milestone in his professional journey.



In the mixed doubles category, the pair of Sanjai Srivatsa Dhanraj and Maneesha K faced tough competition but ultimately fell short in the summit clash against Malaysian opponents.

■ Udit Kumar Claims Silver, Abhimanyu Choudhary and Vicky Sharma Bag Bronze at Asian Wrestling Championships

Udit Kumar secured the silver medal in the men's 57kg category at the Asian Wrestling Championships held in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan.
